Colorfast is a ready to use, finely ground blend of synthetic iron oxide pigments and proprietary admixtures designed for coloring cementitious materials and toppings.

USE

Colorfast is used as an integral ad-mixture for permanently coloring **Pentimento, Sgraffino, Rotofino** and **Pasto**.

FEATURES

1. Superior wet-ability, alkali resistant, curing stability and light fastness
2. Unlimited variations of color through pigment blending
3. Integral color maker
4. Flexibility in depth and tone of color
5. ASTM C 979 82 acceptable synthetic iron oxide pigments

INTEGRAL COLORING

When using **Colorfast** always disperse pigments into **COLORMAKER** activators prior to adding powder. This process will allow for greater color consistency.

SHAKE-ON COLORING

Once perfected by the installer the shake-on coloring process allows for a more dramatic variegation in color shading. This is achieved simply by shaking on and toweling small amounts of dry pigment into the wet mix. It is always advisable to include large mock-ups for this coloring technique prior to proceeding with the project.

COVERAGE

Colorfast is available in 10 lb. (4.5 kg.) and 30 lb. (13.6 kg.) pails. Coverage is based upon the desired color intensity and can vary considerably. Standard dosage is from ¼ to 2 cups per bag/box of **Pentimento, Sgraffino, Rotofino**, or **Pasto**.

LIMITATIONS

Do not over apply **Colorfast** to the overlayers. Avoid using water-finishing aids on colored concrete.

WARRANTY

Colorfast is warranted to be of uniform quality within manufacturing tolerances. Since control is not exercised over its use, no warranty, expressed or implied, is made as to the effects of such use. The sellers and manufacturers obligation under this warranty shall be limited to refunding the purchase price of that portion of the material proven to be defective.
